### **Cool Spring Downtown District Receives A Levitt Foundation Grant for Juneteenth, Announces 2026 Events Calendar**

Cool Spring Downtown District (CSDD) is thrilled to share that we have been selected as a 2026 Levitt Festival Grant recipient, which will support the 2026 Juneteenth Jubilee, held on June 19, 2026, from 5PM-11PM in Festival Park. The Levitt Family Foundation supports more than 1,000 free outdoor concerts nationwide in 100+ towns and cities across all 50 states plus Washington, D.C. and Puerto Rico. This year's festival grantees were selected from a pool of more than 600 applicants to receive grants of up to \$5,000 and hail from over 30 states across the country. CSDD is honored to be a national recipient of this award and deeply grateful to the City of Fayetteville and our supporting partners, who help make these free community events possible for our City's residents and visitors.

On behalf of the City of Fayetteville, Cool Spring Downtown District curates and hosts the annual Juneteenth Jubilee, now in its fifth year. We are delighted to bring back this community celebration honoring Black American contributions to history, arts, and the overall fabric of American culture. Our goal is to provide a thoughtful, inclusive, educational, and joyfully entertaining event for all, focused on the history of the holiday, as well as promoting a spirit of unity and progress.

The Jubilee Planning Committee is excited to announce our headlining stage talent, once contracting is final. This year, we will be connecting the threads of the Black American experience from the past, the present, and looking toward the future through the lens of cultural Afrofuturism. The Jubilee is one of CSDD's biggest yet intimate events of the year, welcoming nearly 20,000 people throughout the day who gather with friends, families, and neighbors to celebrate community, culture, and the arts.
